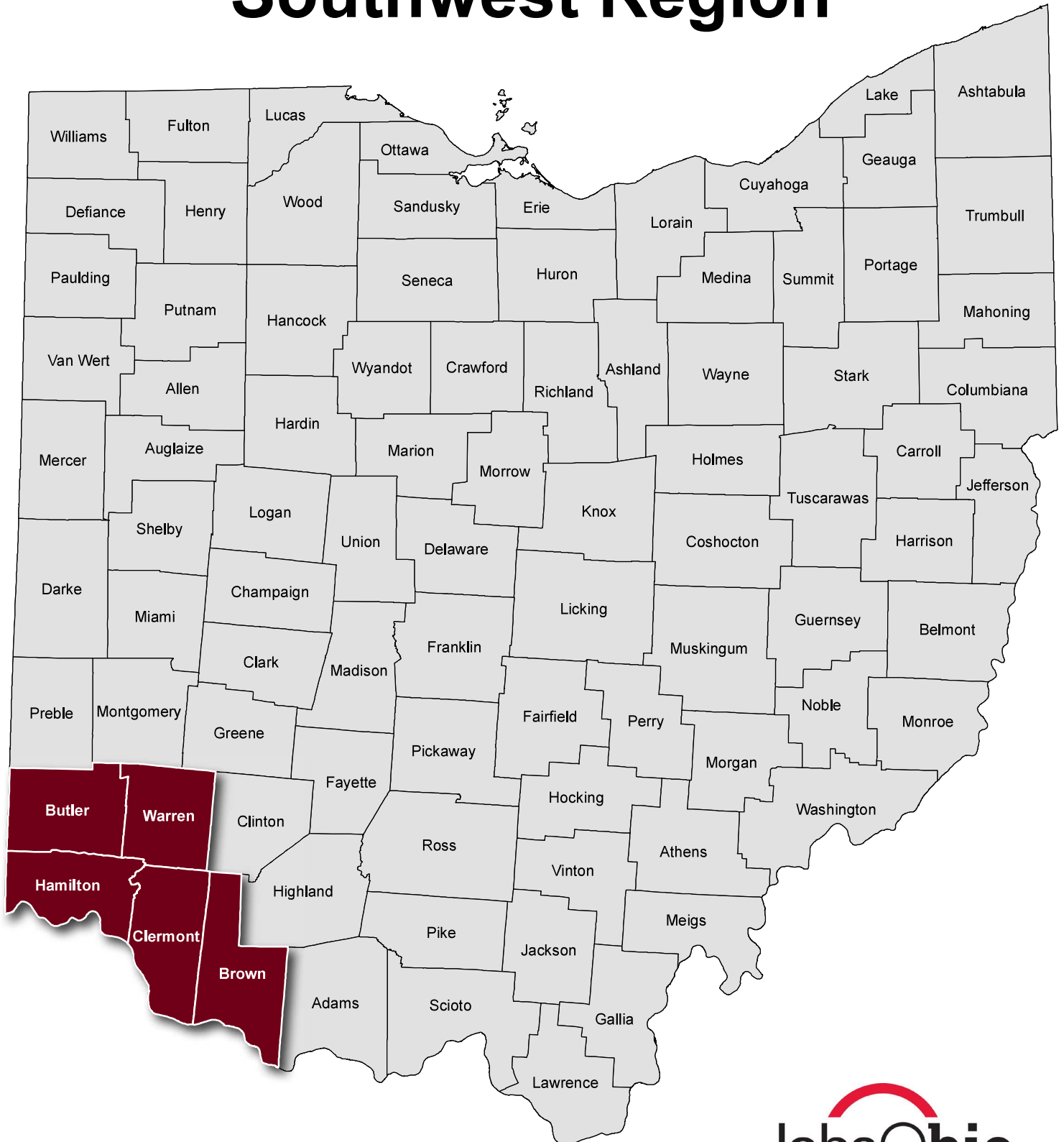

Regional Occupations Report

This report helps returning citizens identify the most promising occupations to find employment in the region of Ohio where they plan to live. The Labor Market Information Bureau at the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services created this report specifically for justice-involved Ohioans.

Here are details on the information in the report:

Column 1: Openings Level ★ ★ ★	Three-star jobs have the most job openings in the region. Two-star and one-star jobs are less in demand, but many great opportunities still exist, especially for a job seeker with the training or experience needed.
Column 2: Occupation Title	We listed the standard job titles used in government reports. Each employer will create their own unique job names, so the positions you apply for may not exactly match the titles in this report.
Column 3: Estimated Job Openings	We used historical data and business surveys to predict how many people will be hired in this occupation each year in the region. The jobs with the most regional annual openings are listed first.
Column 4: Estimated Entry Wage	Every employer will pay a different starting wage, but these averages allow you to compare between occupations. You should expect to earn more than this starting wage after gaining experience, doing a good job, and moving up the career ladder.
Column 5: Occupation Type	The job categories in this report are known to employ restored citizens, although most employers will ask for more details about the nature of the felony conviction.
Column 6: Typical Education	This is the most common education level for people in the occupation now. Employers set their own qualifications and some may require you to have more training than listed on this report.
Column 7: Experience	Some jobs require prior experience in a similar occupation. This is most common in supervisory positions.
Column 8: On-the-Job Training	This means the employer will train you after hiring you. This may last for one month or less, 1 to 12 months, or more than 12 months. Apprenticeships are paid positions that combine work with classroom training.
Column 9: Occupation Code	This is the numerical Standard Occupational Classification (SOC) code that the government assigns to keep track each type of job.
